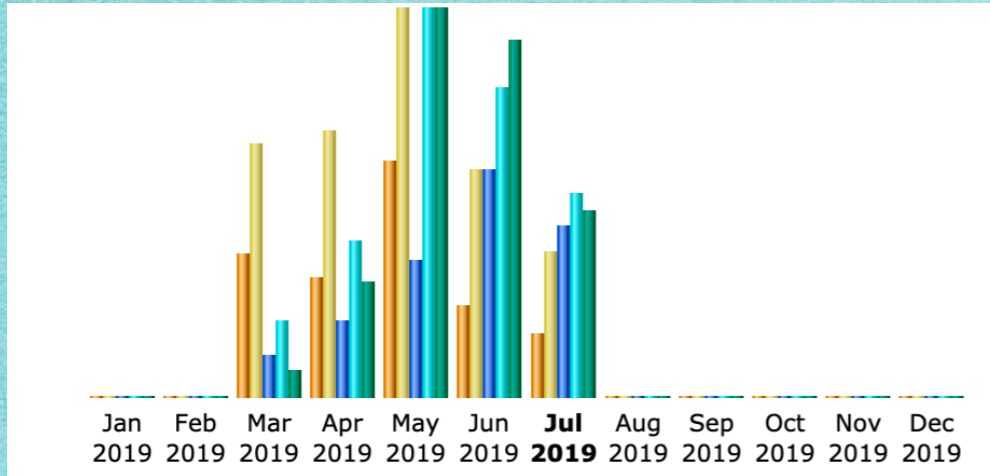
About US - Debbie & Victoria

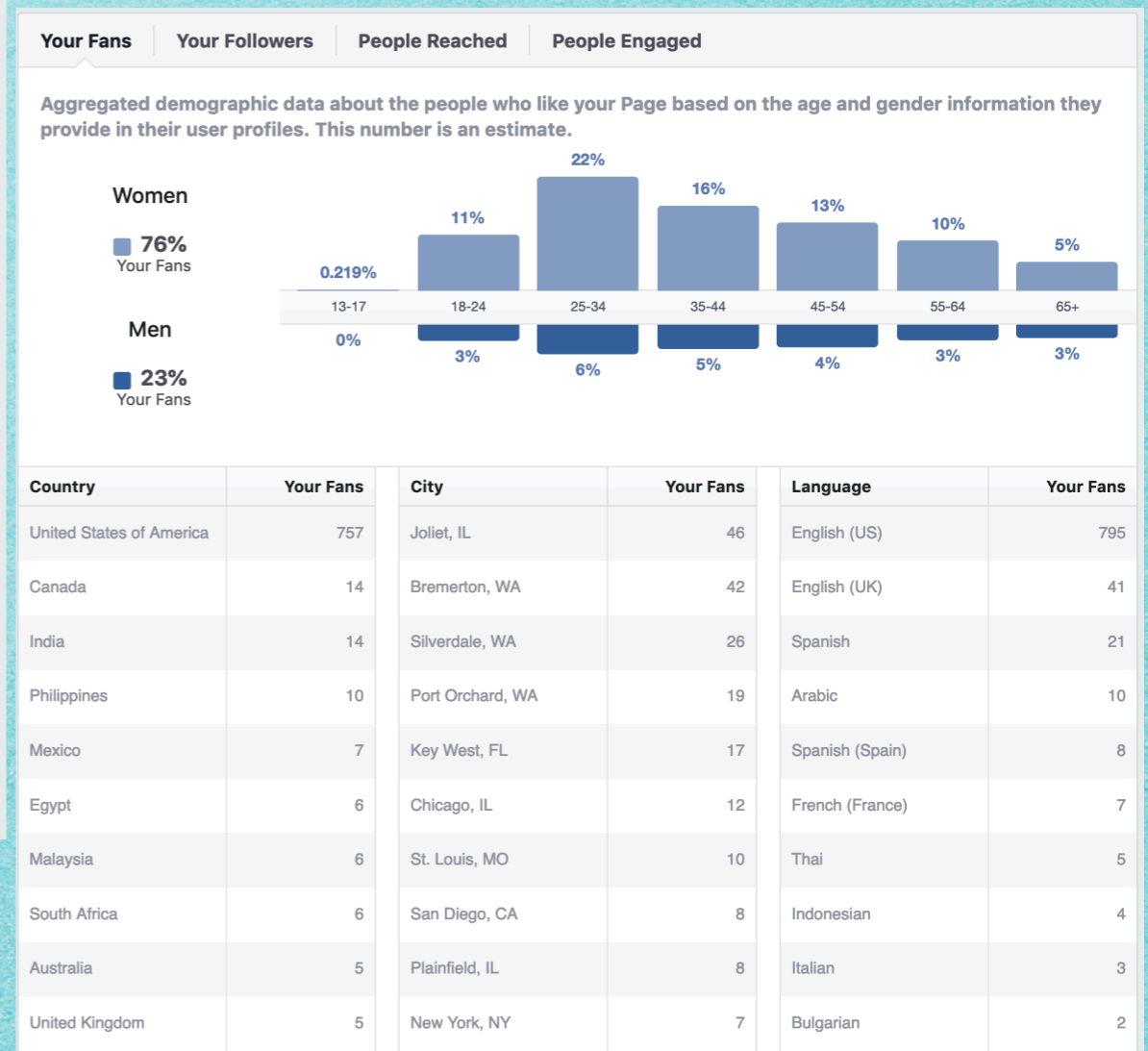
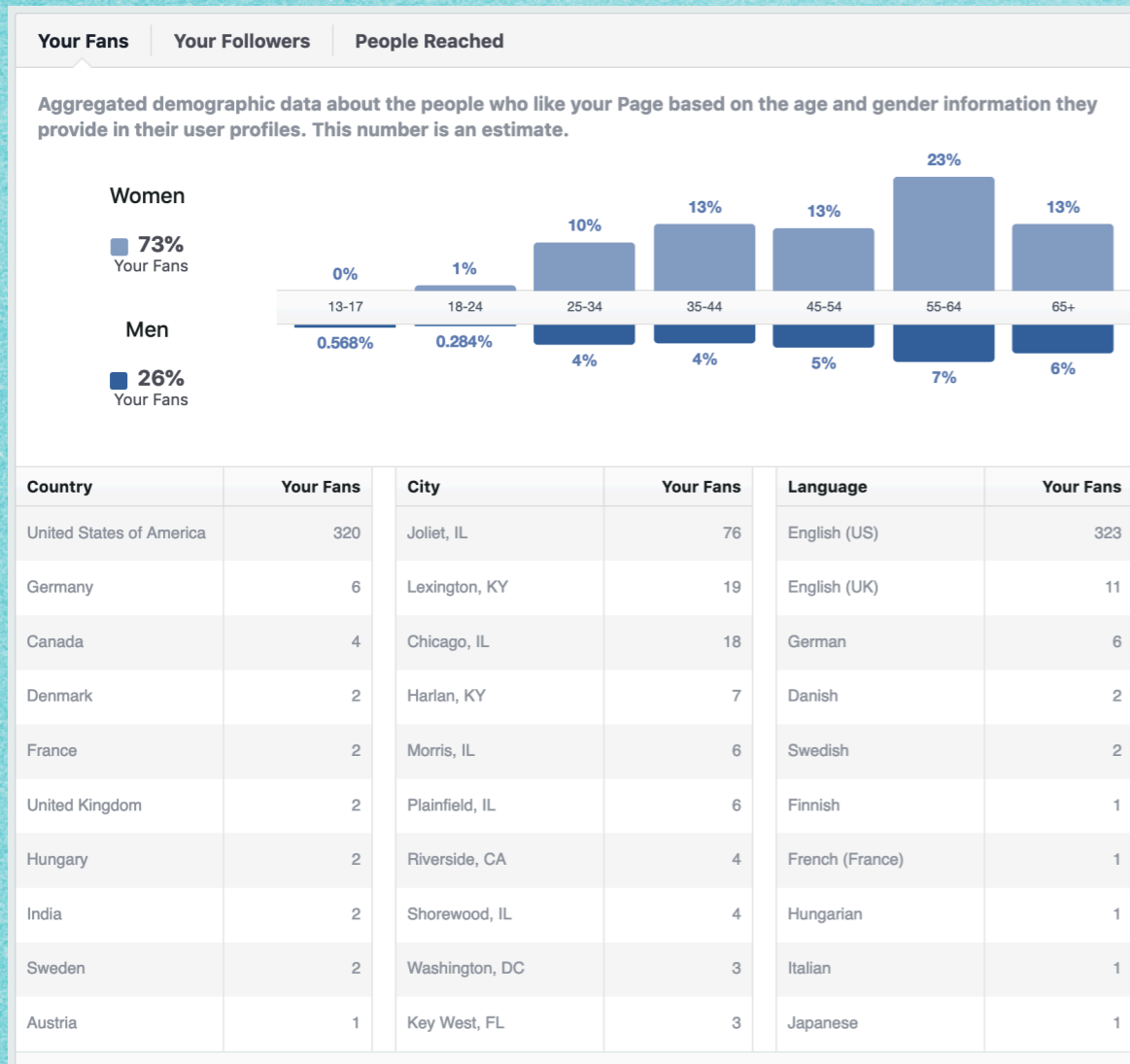
